Code, Construction & Zoning Office

Hours: Monday–Friday, 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM

This office handles:

- Rental property applications
- Bulk trash applications
- Construction permits and inspections

Bulk trash pickup will take place every Tuesday.

Fee: \$10 per sticker

All rental properties must be inspected annually, regardless of tenant changes.

Late application fees will be waived for 2026.

Inspection requests must be submitted in writing and are conducted on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Beach Information

- Midway Beach will continue to operate as usual with its own lifeguards, badge checkers, and badges.
- White Sands Beach will be protected by Seaside Park lifeguards.

A Seaside Park seasonal, senior, weekly, or daily badge will be required for White Sands Beach.

Berkeley Township badges will not be honored.

Trash & Recycling Schedule

- Trash Pickup: Tuesdays, beginning April 7 (if Berkeley picks up trash on Monday, April 6 then this date will change to Tuesday, April 14).
- Bulk trash pickup: Tuesdays, beginning April 7. All bulk trash must have a sticker that can be purchased at the Code, Construction & Zoning Office.
- Recycling Pickup: Wednesdays, beginning April 8

Schedule subject to change.

Important Collection Guidelines

- Robo cans are not permitted
- The Borough does not provide garbage cans, recycling cans, or dumpsters
- Garbage cans may not exceed 45 gallons
- Filled cans may not exceed 50 pounds
- Do not purchase 48-gallon cans

- Heavy-duty 2–3 mil black plastic bags may be used instead of cans
