NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following ordinance was introduced and passed by the Borough Council on first reading at a meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Seaside Park held on the 16th day of April, 2026, and will be considered for second reading and final passage at a regular meeting of the Borough Council to be held on the **6th day of May, 2026**, at the second-floor Council Chambers, located at Sixth & Central Avenues, Seaside Park, New Jersey at which time and place any persons desiring to be heard upon the same will be given the opportunity to be so heard.

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEASIDE PARK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEASIDE PARK SO AS TO AMEND CHAPTER 390, ENTITLED “SOLID WASTE”

WHEREAS, the Borough of Seaside Park is a body politic pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:60-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:66-1 et seq., the governing body of a municipality may provide for the collection or disposal of solid waste and make, amend, repeal, and enforce all such ordinance as may be deemed necessary and proper for the introduction, operation, and management of such system.

BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the Borough of Seaside Park, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. §390-3 of Chapter 390 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Seaside Park, entitled “Municipal garbage and trash collection program established” shall hereby be amended to read as follows:

§390-3 Municipal garbage and trash collection program established.

There is hereby established a program for the municipal collection of garbage and bulk trash from all residences and commercial and institutional establishments within the Borough of Seaside Park, except those located in the Boardwalk Zoning District, hotels and motels, restaurants with seating capacity of 40 or more person(s), and as conditioned by any governmental agency approval, permit or site plan.

SECTION 2. §390-7 of Chapter 390 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Seaside Park, entitled “Garbage and trash containers” shall hereby be amended so as to delete the prohibition of Roll-out cans from §390-7E, and should read as follows:

§390-7E

Use of Robo-cans is prohibited.

SECTION 3. §390-7 of Chapter 390 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Seaside Park, entitled “Garbage and trash containers” shall hereby be amended so as to add dumpster regulations to read as follows:

Add:

§390-7

G. Properties requesting use of dumpsters must confirm type, size, and pick up location with the Public Works Supervisor.

H. Dumpsters must have a lid to keep out rain and wildlife.

I. Dumpsters must be kept clear for service and shall be kept in good, safe condition.

J. The Borough is not liable for damage to dumpsters during pickup or damage to dumpster enclosures.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed.

SECTION 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
