

MARRIAGE LICENSE INSTRUCTIONS

Getting Started

- ❖ If you are a resident of NJ, you will schedule an appointment with the Registrar's Office in the town you reside. If you live out of state, you will schedule an appointment with the Registrar's Office in the town where your ceremony will take place.
- ❖ If you are a resident of Seaside Park or live out-of-state and are getting married in Seaside Park, you will need to schedule an appointment with our Registrar's Office. - ❖ You may fill out the marriage license application ahead of your appointment, or you may wait until your appointment to fill it out with us, but <u>please do not sign/endorse any part of the application until you are in the presence of the Municipal Registrar during your appointment. All signatures must be physically witnessed by the Municipal Registrar, as you are signing under oath.</u>

The Appointment

- For your Marriage License Appointment, you will need to bring the following:
 - Valid ID, in the form of a Driver's License, Passport, or State/Federal ID
 - If you are using a Driver's License as your ID, your address must be current OR it must be accompanied by the DMV-issued change of address documentation.
 - Proof of NJ residency by at least one applicant.
 - Proofs include Driver's License with current address or DMV-issued change of address documentation, tax bill, utility bill, or voter registration.
 - If both applicants live out-of-state, you do not have to provide proof of residency.
 - o You must know your Social Security Number (for US citizens).
 - A witness, 18 years or older, must be present and show valid ID.
 - If you have been previously married and divorced, you must know the date that the divorce took effect, and the <u>full</u> First, Middle, and Last (Maiden) name of your

former spouse. You only need to know the date of your divorce and name of your former spouse. You do not need to provide documentation to us.

\$28 Application Fee (cash or check). We also accept card payments with a 2.95% fee.

Please note: all documents in a foreign language must be accompanied by a certified English translation.

After The Appointment

- ❖ After your appointment, there is a mandatory 72-hour waiting period before your marriage license can be issued. This is mandated by the State. Please plan accordingly. If a waiver is needed, you will need to obtain a Superior Court order.
- ❖ A marriage license application is valid for six months. During that time, you can schedule your license to be issued.
- Once issued, the marriage license is valid for 30 days, meaning you should plan to have your license issued within 30 days of your ceremony.
 - Emergencies happen! If something comes up, please reach out to us, we are here to help you!

The Ceremony

- ❖ At the ceremony, you must have the following people sign your marriage license:
 - The Officiant
 - The Officiant <u>MUST</u> list the title that gives them the authority to officiate, such as Minister, Mayor, etc.
 - If the Officiant is unsure, please contact us and we can provide you with instructions for the Officiant.
 - Witness 1 (must provide Printed Name, Address, and Signature)
 - Witness 2 (must provide Printed Name, Address, and Signature)
- * Remember, you must have <u>all four copies</u> signed by the people above.
- Please make sure the marriage license is filled out in pen, carefully, and please do not scribble over mistakes or cross out words.
- The marriage license must be filed in order to get a certified copy, which is the legal proof of your marriage.

Four Copies

- There will be four copies of your marriage license, remember all four copies must be signed!
 - Copy 1 must be dropped off at the municipality where the ceremony took place, and it will be forwarded to the State of New Jersey.
 - Copy 2 must be dropped off at the municipality where the ceremony took place, and it will be retained as a record at that municipality.
 - Copy 3 is for you for informational purposes. This copy is not a legal certificate; to obtain your legal certificate, you must request a certified copy of your marriage license from the municipality where your ceremony took place, and they will provide you a copy of your marriage license on State-Certified paper with a raised seal.
 - o Copy 4 will be retained by the Officiant who performed your ceremony

After the Ceremony

- ❖ Within 5 days of your ceremony, please submit copies 1 & 2 of your marriage license to the municipality where the ceremony took place.
- ❖ To obtain the legal copy of your marriage license, you must request a certified copy from the municipality where the ceremony took place. Copy 3 is <u>NOT</u> a legal copy of your marriage license.
- ❖ The municipality where your ceremony took place will retain a copy of your marriage license. If you need another copy in the future, you can submit a certified copy application to the municipality where your ceremony was held.
- ❖ Alternatively, instead of requesting a certified copy from the municipality, you can request a certified copy of your marriage license online through the State; however, please be advised it will take a minimum of 8-12 weeks to get to you.
